Brookside High School is pleased to offer you the opportunity to customize and personalize your parking space for the 2024-2025 school year. We are excited to have the class of 2025 start this creative and fun senior year event to show your school spirit.

Before deciding if you would like to paint your space please take the following under consideration and remember that **this a Class of 2025 Activity ONLY!** Questions regarding the sale of parking spaces and the painting process should be directed to Assistant Principal, Mr. Frank, at cfrank@sheffieldschools.org or Mr. DeLuca at bdeluca@sheffieldschools.org.

Requirements to Paint Your Parking Spot:

- Students must purchase their own paint and materials in order to paint their assigned parking spot.
- Spaces will be available to paint on Wednesday, August 14th from 8:00 am- 3:00 pm. **For those students who purchase a parking spot with an existing painting on the spot or may need to apply a base color to their spot, you will be able to come up to school on Tuesday, August 13th from 11:00 - 3:00 pm to prep the spot for the next day.** If you are unable to paint your spot during the assigned time other arrangements **may be able** to be coordinated through the Brookside High School administration. Please be aware that teachers will be working in the building preparing their classrooms and the building will have limited availability. **You will not be permitted to clean any paint materials or supplies inside the building.** **If inclement weather occurs, the rain dates will be Thursday, August 15th and Friday, August 16th from 8:00 am - 3:00 pm.**
- Prior to painting, your parking space must be purchased through Brookside High School. Parking costs \$30.00 dollars for the year and will be on sale starting Friday, August 2nd. **A Parent signature is REQUIRED before a parking space will be sold to students.**
- An emphasis will be made to sell eligible parking spots in the Brookside High School student lot.

Design Criteria:

- **Design must be turned in by Friday August 9th to be pre-approved by Administration**
- Design must be school-appropriate.
- Design may not include offensive language, references to drugs, tobacco, weapons, or alcohol and must appropriately represent all members of the Brookside student body and greater Sheffield-Sheffield Lake community.
- Design may not include double or hidden meanings, suggestive innuendos, or divisive language/content.
- The submitted and approved design must be followed!
- **STUDENTS MAY NOT paint over yellow parking lines or white numbers.**
- For those parking spots where a design is already in place, the student will be responsible for preparing the parking spot for their new design.



Senior Parking Spot Design Considerations

Materials needed (All materials must be provided by student):

- Latex paint: Exterior-Water Based (Home Depot, Sherwin-Williams, Lowe's) (**not concrete paint**)
No oil based paints No reflective paints No spray paint
- Brushes, rollers for rough surface, extension handles or sponge to apply paint (nothing else permitted)
- Paint trays
- Masking tape to mark off the 2 inch border from parking lines. Chalk to sketch design, stencils for lettering help
- Broom to sweep spot
- Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans, paper towels
- Plastic containers for water, paint and brushes
- Stool or towel to sit on
- Sunscreen, hats, sunglasses, water, snacks, clothes you don't mind getting paint all over. Appropriate school attire must be worn

Painting Tips:

- For those parking spots where a design is already in place, the student will be responsible for preparing the parking spot for their new design.
- Tape the edges of your spot with a 2 inch margin before painting.
- Do not paint on the white lines or parking lot curbs.
- Sweep the dirt and pebbles off the spot.
- Use chalk to draw out your sketch.
- Start painting at the front of your spot out to the end (front bumper to back bumper)..others working beside you and you cannot step on their spot.
- Consider making a stencil ahead of time for lettering or detailed images to save a lot of time.
- Bring extra plastic containers (no glass) for water and brushes.
- Bring a drop cloth or garbage bags to put under paint cans. **NO** paint is permitted outside your spot.
- Limit your paint palette as the quarts of paint are expensive or share colors with a friend.
- It will take 2 quarts of paint to cover the spot if you are using a solid color.
- Your family may already have leftover exterior house paint at home that you can use. Open the paint can at home and check to see if it is still usable before the paint date.
